

# Neighborhood Meeting to Discuss Proposed Shadelands Gateway Specific Plan

In May 2011, Property Development Centers, a Safeway company, owner of the 25 acres located on the northwest corner of Ygnacio Valley Road and Oak Grove Road, submitted a Pre-Application request for the City Council to consider an amendment of the existing General Plan land use designation from Business Park to General Retail. On August 2, 2011, the City Council endorsed the idea of processing a General Plan Amendment through the creation of the Shadelands Gateway Specific Plan. The Council authorized the creation of an Advisory Committee (AC) comprised of city officials, business leaders, and residents. The purpose of the AC is to develop the Shadelands Gateway Specific Plan for the property and make a recommendation to the City Council.

In addition to the monthly public AC meetings, Property Development Centers is hosting community meetings in the existing office building located on the site. We invite all members of the Walnut Creek community to attend. The purpose of these meetings is to update the community on the progress of the AC and to listen to your comments regarding the future development of the site. Property Development Centers will share feedback from the neighborhood meetings at the ensuing AC meeting.

The first neighborhood meeting on February 8<sup>th</sup> had a great turnout! Our next meeting is scheduled for **Tuesday, <u>April 10<sup>th</sup> from 6:45 pm to 8:30 pm</u>**. We hope to see you there.

# Update: What's Happening with the Safeway Development?

The Shadelands Gateway Specific Plan Advisory Committee ("AC") met for the 3<sup>rd</sup> time on February 22nd to discuss the 25 acres of land that Safeway would like to develop at the corner of Oak Grove Road and Ygnacio Valley Road. Six members of the public raised questions about the potential traffic impacts, economic impacts on surrounding shopping centers, and the types of uses to be considered. Two people expressed specific concerns about the viability of the existing Nob Hill store at Citrus Center if Safeway were to build a proposed 55K sq. ft. store at this location.

Project consultants discussed the relative size of the parcel and compared it to the smaller, 22 acre Clayton Valley Shopping Center, located at the corner of Ygnacio Valley Road and Clayton Road. The consultants separated the AC Committee into two groups and led them through a design charrette intended to capture members' visions for the property on paper. This exercise allowed the teams to map out the types of buildings they thought might work well on the site. Neither group had any large or medium box retail with the exception of a proposed new Safeway. Both groups included public spaces, retail and mixed uses.

Public participation in this process is encouraged. The best way to get involved is to attend one of the monthly AC meetings (see article in this month's issue for specific dates/times). The next AC meeting is scheduled for <u>Tuesday, March 27<sup>th</sup> from 7-9 pm</u> in the 3<sup>rd</sup> floor conference room a Walnut Creek City Hall. #### Upcoming Woodlands Board Elections By Ed Wohlers

Are you looking for an opportunity to become more involved in our community? The Woodlands Board of Directors is comprised of four elected and several appointed positions. As required in the by-laws, the elected positions serve two-year terms. Board of Director positions that are up for election in 2012 are President and Secretary.

The <u>President</u> leads the Association and has general supervision, direction and control of Association affairs, subject to the control of the Board of Directors. Responsibilities include corresponding with existing and potential advertisers, communicating with neighbors, and representing the neighborhood at government meetings, with a time commitment of 5-10 hours/month. The <u>Secretary</u> maintains the corporate records, meeting minutes, records of the proceedings, and other projects as necessary, with a 1-2 hours/month commitment. Both positions require regular attendance at monthly Saturday morning board meetings.

All residents of the Woodlands over the age 18 are eligible for these positions. Interested candidates are invited to submit brief statements of interest (up to 200 words) to the Woodlands Board for consideration. Eligible candidates' statements of interest will appear in the June newsletter. A ballot will be included in the July newsletter. # Secondhand Smoke in Walnut Creek

Five communities here in Contra Costa County (unincorporated Contra Costa, Richmond, Martinez, Pleasant Hill and Pinole) have adopted laws to protect people from secondhand smoke in outdoor public areas, including within 20 feet of building doors and windows open to the public and in outdoor dining areas. All five communities offer some protections in multi-family housing. Walnut Creek has none of these types of protections in place.

Science shows that even brief exposures to secondhand smoke in places like outdoor dining or in building doorways can be harmful. Low levels of exposure to secondhand smoke have been shown to trigger sudden blood clots, strokes, heart attacks, asthma attacks and aggravate existing lung conditions. The U.S. Surgeon General concluded that there is no safe level of exposure to secondhand smoke. The California Air Resource Board has declared secondhand smoke a toxic air contaminant.

The Tobacco Prevention Coalition is working with Walnut Creek residents to advocate for the City Council to strengthen secondhand smoke protections. The Coalition provides training to develop advocacy skills, speaking points, sample letters and more. # **CERT Training Begins in April**

Are you interested in learning how you can safely help your family and your community in the event of a disaster? If so, consider becoming a Community Emergency Response Team member (CERT). CERT training classes will be offered on Wednesdays from 6:30-10pm, April 18 - May 23, at Tony La Russa's Animal Rescue Foundation on 2890 Mitchell Dr. @ Oak Grove Road. A final hands-on drill will take place from 8 a.m. to 1 p.m. Saturday, June 9 at Heather Farm.

Training topics include but are not limited to: disaster preparedness, how to safely turn off utilities, fire extinguisher use, search and rescue techniques and first aid. CERTs complete a basic 20-hour training before being sworn in as volunteer Disaster Service Workers for the City of Walnut Creek. In the event of a disaster, CERT volunteers first confirm their family's safety before meeting at their pre-designated CERT Staging Area to help the community.
