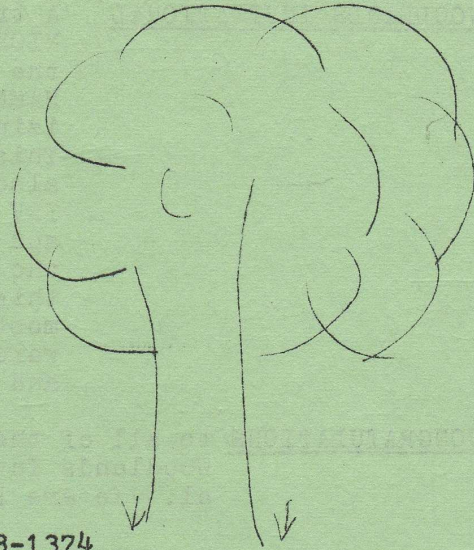

PRESIDENT'S MESSAGE

The Walnut Creek City Council has reversed itself and voted to allow "Famous Pizza To Go" to stay. Only the Woodlands' own Gail Murray voted against it. The Council members felt that there was no essential difference between the Famous Pizza operation, which sells only whole pizzas to go, and Happy Hot Dog or Pete's Deli.

The Council was concerned that the homeowners who suffer from food odors from the Center were not being protected. The Board is soliciting volunteers in the affected areas (Conifer Ct. and Banyan Circle) to be ready for inspections from City staff on short notice. If we can show the staff the problem, we are assured they will enforce the anti-odor parts of the ordinance.
