Some of the items the soldiers are requesting are powdered drink mixes that can be mixed with water (the water over there tastes terrible), sunscreen, chap stick, baby powder, beef jerky, protein bars, cookies, nuts, baby wipes, AT&T calling cards, hand made cards and letters. Please remember that all items are shipped in shoeboxes, so small "individual" type items are most appreciated.

NEIGHBORHOOD HAPPENINGS.....

My holidays started off with a jolt. I went to pick up my 88 year old Mother in Morro Bay. On the way home we decided to get something to eat, so we pulled into **Paso Robles** for lunch. We found a nice place to park and, low and behold we were greeted with a major jolt. We were experiencing the **Paso Robles earthquake**!! Unlike reports from here, it was a major shaker. We got out of town as quick as possible and headed home to a home made bowl of soup, warm fire and a stiff drink. My Mother has been in many a quake, said this was the worst one she had experienced. We heard later that we were within 4 blocks of the buildings that went down.

C.C.Mosquito & Vector Control District. Programs and are funded by our tax dollars, so when you call for their services, there is no charge. Their services include mosquito control using "mosquito" fish to put in ponds or horse troughs. They also furnish advice on how to set up of bait and traps for rodents. For skunks, they lend you a trap and will pickup the trapped animal. The district provides exterminator services for yellow jackets. For ticks and Lyme disease testing, there is a fee for lab services. Call before you take a tick in for current prices for testing and how to transport the tick. We used their service to rid our backyard of yellow jackets. They were fast, efficient and the best part, there was no charge.
