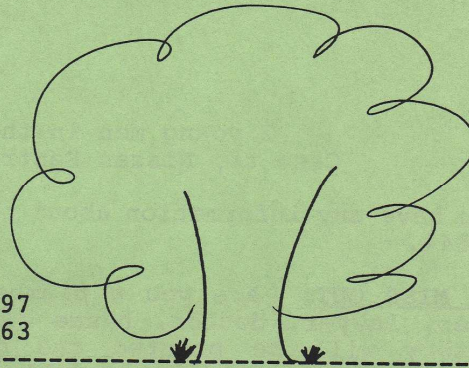

PRESIDENT'S MESSAGE

We are deeply grateful to all of the Woodlands residents who volunteered their time to help distribute and also collect signatures on the special notice concerning the Shadelands and the Character Committee Growth Limitation Plan. We had a tremendous response, over 400 signatures which we presented to City Council Tuesday, May 18 at the Final Public Hearing. We are confident that the City Council now understands our deep concerns for the Woodlands community. Anyone interested in the Shadelands Policy Determinations (Attachment 2) may request a copy from City Hall which outlines alternatives for the Shadelands. Because of the time factor, we were unable to print this 7-page document for all of the Woodlands homes.

After the vote which will probably be early June, we will immediately let you know the outcome. At this time, we feel confident that City Council has heard our voices! Again we are grateful for your continued support and dedication in a unified effort to maintain the high standards of our community.

We presented a check for \$100 to Valle Verde School last month which came in a timely manner as they celebrated their Grand Opening of the new multi-purpose room. Mayor Wolfe attended along with members of the Mt. Diablo Unified School District administration. The money we donated came from our Treasury fund and they plan to put it towards their new P.A. system. The multi-purpose room was dedicated in memory of Diane Grimm.
