# **New BART Board President**


Woodlands resident Gail Murray is the new President of the BART Board of Directors for 2008. Gail was elected to the BART Board of Directors in 2004 to represent District 1, which includes the Orinda, Lafayette, Walnut Creek, Pleasant Hill, Concord and North Concord BART Stations.

Gail and her husband Jim moved to the Woodlands in 1970, drawn by the attractiveness of Walnut Creek and the knowledge that BART would soon be serving the city. Gail got her start in elective offices in 1972, when she was elected to the Woodlands Homeowners' Association Board, serving as president in 1974. She successfully lobbied the Walnut Creek City Council to limit the number of service stations at the

Oak Grove and Ygnacio Valley intersection and to prevent Citrus from becoming a commuters' short cut by prohibiting a right turn onto Treat. She also worked on passage of the bond issue establishing the Lime Ridge Open Space to the east of the Woodlands.

Gail served on Walnut Creek's Transportation and Planning Commissions before she was appointed in 1981 to a vacancy on the City Council. From 1982-1992, she was elected to two subsequent terms and served twice as Mayor. While Mayor, she dedicated the Lesher Regional Center for the Arts and participated in a consortium that successfully lobbied Caltrans to rebuild the I-680/24 interchange.

In her professional life, Gail is a transportation consultant. She and Jim have two children that went through the Valle Verde, Foothill Intermediate and Northgate schools. Their son Mike is a MD living in Davis, CA, and their daughter Julie is an Assistant City Manager for Durham, NC.


