Woodlands Good Neighbor Reminders

Here are two "good neighbor" reminders for all of us to keep in mind. First, it's important for our individual properties and that of the overall neighborhood that we be responsible and dispose of trash. While some trash finds its way to our streets and lawns when strangers park their cars and throw out litter, many times the trash originates when our garbage containers spill debris during the weekly trash pickup. Sometimes the drivers dump the trash too quickly and more trash than usual escapes. If you find that this is occurring too frequently, you can call Allied Waste at (925) 603-1144 to complain.

Secondly, if you are a dog owner, please remember to carry waste bags to pick up after your dog while walking in the neighborhood and open space trails. Dog owners now have several options on what kinds of waste bags to use (plastic shopping bags, specially made waste bags with handle ties, and even biodegradable bags) and ways to carry them (tied to their lead, a store bought pouch that hooks to the led, or simply held in a pocket or hand). Dog owners can foster goodwill with their neighbors by being consistent and reliable when cleaning up after their dogs.



Contra Costa Water District's Pilot Water Efficient Landscape Rebate Program

Are you tired of mowing your lawn? Are you getting frustrated paying high water bills? Are you thinking of changing the look of your front yard? If you've answered yes to any of these questions, you may be interested in the Contra Costa Water District's (CCWD) pilot program to "lose the lawn and grow a garden" rebate program. Their water efficient landscape rebate program provides rebates to Woodland residents (and

others within the water district) to convert water-thirsty lawns to waterefficient landscapes. This program is available to residents whose water account is in good standing, have a healthy lawn



in their front yard that is currently maintained, and is irrigated by a sprinkler system in good working condition. A minimum of 300 square feet of lawn must be converted. Smaller projects will be considered if they eliminate 100% of the front lawn or areas visible to the public.

An application to the program must be submitted to CCWD and you must be pre-approved before the removal of any lawn. Funding is limited and applications will be accepted on a first-come, firstserved basis. 




