This is just a reminder that Election Day is Tuesday, November 6th. In the Walnut Creek City Council race, Walnut Creek City Councilman, Kish Rajan announced (Sept. 11th) that he was suspending his campaign for re-election to City Council to take a position as Director of the Governor's Office of Business and Economic Development. While his name will still appear on the election ballot he has indicated that he

will not serve if elected and encourages voters to vote for other qualified candidates.

That leaves four candidates remaining for the three openings for City Council – Mayor Bob Simmons, Barry Grove, Loella Haskew and Woodlands resident Justin Wedel. Registered voters should evaluate the candidates and vote on Election Day, November 6th.

Abrupt End to AC Meetings

Re: Safeway Development Proposal

The 10th meeting of the Shadelands Gateway Advisory Committee was held on October 1st at St. Matthew's Church. The turnout was the largest to date. The purpose of the meeting was to reaffirm or revise 11 "Planning Principles" regarding the proposed rezoning of Safeway's 25-acre parcel at Ygnacio Valley Road and Oak Grove road from business to retail. These 11 Planning Principles were illustrated on large boards around the perimeter of the room and the consultant asked attendees to 'take a break' 5 minutes into the meeting to review the boards and illustrations.

Mayor Bob Simmons addressed the AC Committee and the attendees at the start of the meeting that the public comment period would come at the start of the meeting, rather than at the end. This was a change both from prior meetings and from the printed agenda for the October 1st meeting, where public comment was scheduled to occur after the review of the planning principles.

Public comment began with 5 students from the Foothill Middle School ECK Club coming forth to express their concerns over possible deterioration of the existing Encina Grande shopping center, where Safeway currently has a store. Other comments included requests for a bowling alley, senior housing, and caution from a downtown developer against 'analysis paralysis.' Several people spoke in favor of the proposal including a Safeway employee. Concerns about traffic remain paramount.

The meeting was 2.5 hours in length, with 30 minutes for public comment fully utilized. The bulk of the meeting focused on the 11-member AC Committee's review of the 11 Planning Principles, part of the process that was to lead

to the AC committee's drafting of a specific plan for review by the City Council when considering Safeway's proposal to rezone its property.

After the 11th principle was reviewed, the Mayor surprisingly announced that this was the final AC Meeting and thanked the AC members for their time. Mayor Pro Tem Kish Rajan also thanked the AC members. Most AC members had not been informed that this was the final meeting in the process, and the committee was not given the opportunity to continue their work which included drafting a Specific Plan for this proposal as originally planned.

The Contra Costa Times ran an October 5th article about the disbanding of the Advisory Committee. The city website states: "There will be no more Advisory Committee Meetings." While the AC Committee is no longer part of the process to review Safeway's proposal, according to the city website, a draft Specific Plan will be open to public comment in 2013.

Next Steps - City staff will be working with the consultant to draft the Specific Plan based on the 11 Planning Principles and the work completed by the AC. This Plan will go to each of the City Commissions for review and their will be an opportunity for public comment. An environmental impact report will also be prepared in connection with this project. Public comment can be submitted for this as well.




