McDonald's At Citrus Circle Update, Committee Meeting September 25th 3:00 pm By Joe Casey

The Woodlands Board is closely monitoring the progress of the McDonald's fast-food establishment application to lease the former bank building at the corner of Citrus Drive and Oak Grove. The initial application was submitted to the Walnut Creek City Planning department on July 1st. By regulation, the City has 30 days to respond with either an approval to proceed, or a denial due to the application not meeting the City's initial requirements. In this case, the initial application has been returned to McDonald's with a request for more details on conditions the city feels have not been initially met. The Board doesn't have specific details of what additional information the City is requesting, but initial conditions to meet include a detailed arborist study, traffic study, parking study, noise/odor study, etc.

The Board is in constant contact with the City's planning department, and will continue to monitor developments. If you would like to be kept apprised of further developments outside the cycle of the monthly newsletter, send an email to <u>woodlandsassn@yahoo.com</u> to be added to our email list. The Board is also organizing a community meeting on *Saturday Sept. 25 at 3pm at the Woodlands Cabana Club, 111 Longleaf Drive,* to allow the community to hear updates on the application as well as voice your opinions. City Planner Jeremy Lorchirco has volunteered to attend, and we very much appreciate Jeremy taking a Saturday afternoon off to come and meet our residents. McDonald's will not be attending this initial meeting, but has requested that they be provided with an opportunity to address the community at a future date, and the Board has agreed to facilitate.
